Nestled in the heart of Doha, Qatar, the school is proudly celebrating a momentous milestone—50 years of shaping young minds, fostering academic excellence, and nurturing a vibrant sense of community.

During its growing years, the relocation of M.E.S Indian School from Salata to a sprawling campus with imposing buildings at Abu Hamour symbolized its perseverance and marked the beginning of a journey toward a promising future. The school's affiliation with the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, further elevated its stature, enabling the first batches of Grades X and XII to appear for the Board Examinations in 1982 and 1984, respectively.

The subsequent decades witnessed remarkable growth and expansion at M.E.S. 



The students of M.E.S. have consistently achieved outstanding results in the Board Examinations over the years. M.ES S.ecures remarkable results in Science, Commerce and Humanities Streams in CLASS XII CBSE Examination 2024 and a record Breaking Performance in CLASS - X CBSE Examination 2024.

Among the 522 students who appeared in the Class XII board examination, 350 students secured the distinction, 21 students secured 100 marks in various subjects, and 32 students secured A1 in all subjects. In Class X, among 555 who appeared for the board exam, 380 students secured distinction, 17 secured 100 marks in various subjects and 23 students A1. Further, keeping with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the school has incorporated skill subjects in the curriculum with a primary objective of engaging students with realworld and project-related tasks.
